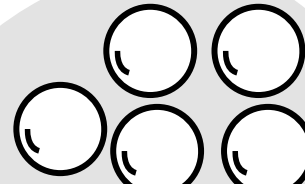
Gameboard: 6 - 11 Years

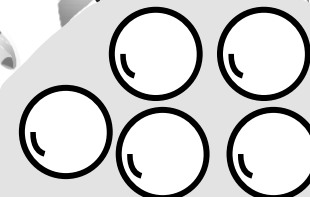
1. Read about ocean animals.

15. Describe what sea-loving creature you would like to be.



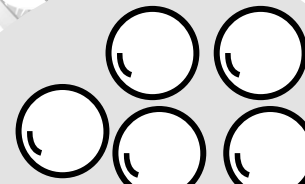
