

VOTE IN PERSON

WHEN CAN I VOTE?

During early voting, you can vote at the Wicomico Youth and Civic Center. If you do not live in Wicomico, early voting centers are listed at elections.maryland.gov.

On November 3, 2020, election day, you will be able to vote at any of the available vote centers listed below:

Bennett Middle School

James M. Bennett High School

Mardela Middle and High School

Salisbury Middle School

HOW WILL I CAST MY VOTE?

During early voting or on election day, you will have the choice to mark a paper ballot by hand or use an electronic device called the ballot marking device. Once you have completed your ballot, an election worker will direct you to insert your ballot into the scanning unit to cast your vote. Your ballot will be scanned and dropped into a secure ballot box.



VOTER REGISTRATION

If you have a Maryland driver's license or MVA-issued ID card, you can register to vote online at elections.maryland.gov. You can also choose to register by completing a paper application either by mail or in person.

To register to vote, you must be:

- A U.S. Citizen;
 - A Maryland resident; and
 - At least 16 years old*.
- You cannot have been:
- Convicted of buying or selling votes;
 - Under guardianship for mental disability and found by a court to be unable to communicate a desire to vote; or
 - Convicted of a felony and currently serving a court-ordered sentence of imprisonment.

*You may register to vote if you are at least 16 years old. You can vote in a primary election as long as you will be 18 years old by the next general election. You must be 18 years old to vote in a general election.

VOTE BY MAIL

HOW DO I APPLY FOR A BALLOT?

To receive your ballot by mail you must complete the mail-in ballot application. Once you complete your application, return it to your local board of elections office prior to the deadline.

HOW WILL I CAST MY BALLOT?

With your mail-in ballot, you will receive detailed instructions on how to complete the ballot. Please read these instructions on how to complete the ballot and promptly return the voted ballot to your local election office. If you mail your voted ballot, the envelope must be postmarked on or before election day and received by the local office by 10 am on the second Friday after the election.
